Music Minors need to attend three of the general recitals plus four more to total seven for the semester. Minors need a total of two semesters of Recital and Program Attendance to meet the requirements.

Please make sure you sign in so we have a concrete record for your grade. You may also count off-campus classical or jazz recitals or concerts (college level or above). Bring your ticket stubs or programs to the office as verification of your attendance.

Make sure you register for Recital and Program Attendance (GMUS 1030 01) or else going to these events will count for nothing. If an event is duplicated (eg. Bach's Literacy Series, Jazz Band), you may only claim it one time.
